ELIGIBILITY

- o Children/Grandchildren/live-in Step-Children of OPSEU Local 101 members
- o Must be pursuing Canadian Public Post-Secondary Education/Training
- o Prior recipients of the OPSEU 101 and OPSEU 143 Scholarship awards are not eligible to reapply

CRITERIA

The successful candidates should:

- o Demonstrate a strong work ethic and exhibit a commitment and determination towards career goals
- o Indication of volunteer work and/or service to the community
- o Submit a 500-word essay describing why you have chosen your particular field of study
- o Submit two letters of reference

AWARD

- o Fifteen (15) \$1,000.00 scholarships to be issued to 15 successful applicants

DETAILS

- o The successful candidates will be judged on the above-mentioned criteria.
- o The successful candidates will be decided by the three Scholarship Committee Members from OPSEU Local 101.
- o Recipients of the Scholarship are responsible to claim monies received on their Income Tax.
- o Should the applicant withdraw from the educational program, the monies must be returned to OPSEU Local 101.
- o Children/Grandchildren/live-in Step-Children of Scholarship Committee members are not eligible to apply.
